OUT OF SCHOOL youth provider sub-recipient contracts are entered into in accordance with the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (WIOA), and the laws of the State of Illinois by and between the **Land of Lincoln Workforce Alliance and Youth Contractors listed below** for the 2020 program year.

Lawrence Education Center, Capital Area Career Center and Fishes and Loaves Outreach applied for WIOA funding through a competitive procurement process to deliver an out-of-school youth program. The youth providers were approved by the Workforce Board and CEOs to deliver training and services to out-of-school youth residing in the counties of Cass, Christian, Logan, Menard and Sangamon.

Term of Agreement

The Out of School Youth Provider contracts shall remain in force until they terminate on June 30, 2021, unless circumstances require a new or revised agreement prior to the termination date.
